Rationale

Display is a reflection of the stimulation the curriculum is generating within the school environment.

Purposes

- encourage and develop a high standard of work within and outside the classroom
- to create an atmosphere which is aesthetically pleasing
- to encourage inter-action
- to be informative and rewarding
- to establish a sense of pride, in both children and staff, in the work produced.

Broad Guidelines

1. Appropriate choice of colours and materials according to the work and age group of the pupils concerned should be used for backing work.
2. There are various methods for display: wall boards, horizontal and suspended, use of solid objects give varied levels in the display.
3. Use of different materials can be used to focus attention – draped material, spotlights, frames or reflecting surfaces.
4. Titles and labelling should be clearly written in the **same style** and **medium** throughout the display. Writing can be generated by computer or by hand.
5. **Paper cutters** should always be used to obtain straight edges for both trimming and mounting.
6. Mounting of individual pieces of work should have the minimum of 1 cm border, preferably double backed.
7. Staples should be the preferred method of securing work to the wall.
8. Displays need maintenance once they are ‘up’.
9. Our display is both informative, celebratory and provides a welcoming environment for the whole school.
10. Each Key Stage has an information board identifying significant information about the school, timetables and staff working within that Key Stage.
11. Display work from different Key stages will be displayed in all corridor areas about the school.
12. Class teachers will be responsible for providing work for specific boards about the school (**Not the actual displaying of the board**)
13. Work for the display boards outside the classrooms will be rotated from work produced within the classrooms per term.
14. There will be additional; boards identified for parents, Governors and enrichment activities such as trips or artists in residence.
15. The school has 3 display cabinets in which 3D items, celebration awards and any other memorabilia within the school community can be displayed.

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
