When Can A Child Start?

Application to HMRC needs to be the term before you wish your child to start accessing their funded hours. Once your application has been successful, you must reconfirm every 13 weeks that your circumstances have not changed and you still meet the eligibility criteria. Depending on when you apply, you may need to reconfirm your eligibility before your child actually starts accessing their funded hours. A child cannot start their funded hours without a code being validated by your childcare provider - your code must be valid on your child's first day.

If parents still need to access childcare and are no longer eligible for the funded hours, they may instead, depending on the reasons why they cannot access they funded hours, be able to use Tax-Free childcare or Universal Credit support to lower their childcare costs.
